SVDH proudly takes a stance against the racial injustices of this country through a public solidarity letter addressed to our community.




After a 3-month hiatus, the Day Home reopens its doors with limited capacity for 112 children, helping parents return to work.

RETURNING TO SCHOOL A BRIGHT LIGHT DURING THE PANDEMIC

When the Day Home closed in March, my wife and I were suddenly balancing the energy of three children while trying to work from home. It was a very difficult time sorting out a new daily routine. Like most families, we were feeling the pressure of being isolated at home, and it was overwhelming to rearrange our lives not knowing when we could get back to our conventional schedules.

While our 4-year-old twin girls and our 5-year-old son had each other to play with — they had no teachers and desperately missed school. Ethan was sad to miss the Move-a-Thon day and the girls missed the family literacy fair and storytlme. They must have asked a thousand times when they could go back to school.

They were so excited to return in July. The children reconnected with friends instantly, work became a lot easier for us, and our neighbors stopped complaining about the noise and stomping feet coming from our apartment.

Throughout these difficulties, the Day Home was instrumental in supporting our family. We cannot express enough how much gratitude we have for Saint Vincent's Day Home.

Our kids have been at Saint Vincent's Day Home since they were two years old, and we could not be happier with their growth. When we drop them off, we know they are in a safe and nurturing environment where the teachers deeply care for them. Our children have learned kindness and empathy. They have learned so much through their projects and developed a love for books.

We consider Saint Vincent's Day Home as a gift for us and are thankful to have had their help during this pandemic.

THE PANDEMIC'S IMPACT

Foundations, businesses, and a community of concerned individuals rallied to support Day Home families impacted by the pandemic. At the end of summer, a needs assessment showed the depth of economic injury to our families. We were grateful to have been able to help in any way — something made possible only through private support from our donors and partners.




