


# A Quarter Century of Day Home Roots

I work as a housekeeper and my husband is a labor worker. We know our kids are being well taken care of while we are at work. Without the Day Home in our lives, I would not have been able to work, which would have been very stressful on the family.

My older daughter was diagnosed with Williams Syndrome as a young child. She was helped academically and well educated by the teachers at the Day Home with their speech and learning programs. It gave her the independence and confidence needed to continue to learn even with her disability.



All of my daughters that attended SVDH have been very happy being there: The education they received set them up for educational success. My daughters have great aspirations for their future; Fernanda wants to be an immigration lawyer and Anabeth aspires to become an architect or electrical engineer. The Day Home gave them their academic start—and for that, we are forever grateful.
